

Univerzitetni študijski program 1. stopnje Geografija Izbirni predmet

Uporabna družbena geografija

Študenti pri predmetu poglobljajo aplikativne metode kabinetnega in terenskega dela na področju družbene geografije ter spoznajo izbrane aktualne domače in tuje primere uporabe rezultatov družbenogeografskih raziskav v praksi. S kritično analizo izbranih primerov se študenti poglobljeno seznanijo z uporabljenimi metodološkimi pristopi za reševanje konkretnih družbenoprostorskih problemov. Ob tem se tudi usposobijo za uporabo izbranega pristopa, pri čemer naj bi si pridobili tudi zmožnost prenosa pridobljenega znanja in kompetenc na reševanje sorodnih problemov. Delo poteka s pomočjo »brainstorminga« in s prilagajanjem obravnavanega raziskovalnega postopka razreševanju konkretnega problema (opredelitev predlogov možnih rešitev - ravnanj, politik). Skupinsko projektno delo vključuje terensko delo, ki ga deloma opravijo študenti v okviru terenskih vaj, deloma pa samostojno.

Podatki o predmetu:

- 2. ali 3. letnik / 2nd or 3rd year | izbirni / mandatory,
- 45 ur predavanj, 15 ur seminarja,
- 6 ECTS.

Preverjanje in ocenjevanje znanja:

- Pisne naloge in poročila do 33,3 % končne ocene,
- Končni izpit do 66,7 % končne ocene.

Applicable Social Geography

During this course, the students get acquainted with current domestic and international examples of applying the results of sociogeographical research into practice. If possible, the presentation is made by the author of the selected example or its user. Through the critical analysis of some selected examples, the students get a deep understanding of the applied methodological approaches for solving actual socio-spatial problems. At the same time, they acquire skills for using the chosen approach, which should also enable them to transfer the acquired knowledge and competences for solving of related problems. The work is carried out with the help of brain-storming and with the adaptation of the discussed research procedure (defining the suggestions for possible solutions - practices, policies). The group project work includes field work, which is partially carried out by the students during field work classes, and partially on their own. Particular attention is paid to the preparation of the final report and presentation, which can be held in front of colleagues or in public.
