Ekonomska geografija in geografija marginalnosti

V okviru predmeta študent pridobi znanje in splošne kompetence glede vprašanj ekonomske geografije in geografije marginalnosti. Študent se uvodoma spozna z zakonitostmi globalne ekonomije in razvojnimi ekonomskimi teorijami ter seznanj z glavnimi smernicami globalne razporeditve središč ekonomije in kapitala. To znanje je osnova za študij teorij ekonomske geografije, od teorij razvoja tržišč, regij in makroregij, transportnih poti, odnosa med centralnim, perifernim in marginalnim prostorom ter globalnimi ekonomskimi tokovi. Študent se seznanj tudi z zgodovino razvoja in aktualnimi dinamikami globalnega finančnega trga ter ekonomski geografiji energentov in rudnin. Študentu predmet omogoča vpogled v poznavanje osnovnih specifik glavnih ekonomskih in finančnih tokov ter obvladovanje geoekonomskega in geopolitičnega analitičnega mišljenja.

Economic geography and geography of marginalization

Student acquires general knowledge and skills on issues of economic geography and geography of marginality. The student initially learns the laws of the global economy and the economic development theories and gets acquainted with guidelines of the global distribution of economic centres. This knowledge is the basis for the study of theory of economic geography, the theory of market development, the concept of regions and the macro-regions, transport routes, the relationship between the central, peripheral and marginal areas, as well as global economic flows. The student is also acquainted with the history of development and current dynamics of the global financial market, as well as economic geography of energy and minerals. The course provides insight into specifics of the main economic and financial flows and the management of geo-economic and geopolitical analytical thinking.
